It provides new readings of some of Dickens's most famous works, including *Oliver Twist*, *Dombey and Son* and *Our Mutual Friend*, as well as of lesser-known texts. Dickens's child characters were a source of inspiration to many medical writers, institutions and journalists, and the book also traces how these groups appropriated Dickensian characters and motifs in order to debate and bolster the authority of new scientific ideas.
